## Monday

Jesus curses the fig tree that had no fruit Jesus weeps over Jerusalem Cleanses the Temple the second time

Mark 11:13-14, Luke 19:41, Matthew 21:12

## Tuesday

Jesus comes across the cursed fig tree - it has withered Prophesies destruction for his enemies Olivet discourse Judas makes a deal with Jewish leaders to betray Jesus

Mark 11:20, Matt 21:28-46, Mark 13, Mark 14:10-11

## Wednesday

The Gospels do not provide events for Wednesday

Isaiah 53:3-5, "He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows, and familiar with suffering. Like one from whom men hide their faces he was despised and we esteemed him not.
